Candidate Requirements:

Minimum 18 Years of Age

High School Diploma or GED

Good Health and Physical ability

Legal U.S. Citizen

Reliable Transportation

Length of Program:

4 Years / 6000 work hours / 640 class hours

Training Hours:

One 4 hour day per week after work during training semesters (not paid)

Steps to Entering Program

1. Complete an application at a Finishing Trades Institute of the Great Lakes Facility.
2. Obtain a Statement of Eligibility form upon acceptance.
3. Obtain a list of DC 1M signatory glazing contractors.
4. Apply and gain employment with a DC 1M signatory contractor.
5. Be initiated in a Local Union Affiliated with The District Council # 1M.
6. Sign up and start attending the Finishing Trades Institute of the Great Lakes.
